Chapter 1

INTRODUCTION

The black race as we know it; is now at a standstill. The key notion here is that twisted brothers and sisters have brought the race to a paradoxical level. Our race as it exists today is no longer the proud race as we once knew it. The race of strong men like King, Marshall, Malcolm X, Mohammad Ali, Booker T. Washington, W.E. Dubois, Marshal Reedom, My late father, and others have now become a race of thugs and weasels who think that they are men. They have no class and culture and are hostile and angry men who are not even one tenth of what we used to be. We are angry with the system and we do not even know why. We mistreat our women and take our angry hostilities out on them. The black male as he is known, today is an endangered species. He is totally lost and he has no way to turn but to take it out on his woman. I have known so many brothers who are very hostile and are unwilling to be open and honest in the way that they relate and interact with people. This is very depressing given the fact that they do not treat their sisters and other black males with self respect. I have noticed that so many black man and black females are angry and quick to argue with individuals for no apparent reason other than the fact that they are upset with someone and or something. This is apparent in the way that they walk around with a hostile attitude. The black race, as I see it is undergoing a tremendous transition in the way that we treat and deal with each other. But one thing is unequivocal and very clear: there is a problem with the way that black males and females treat each other and it is interacting with the kids and our families and unless something is done to correct this problem blacks will be having difficult times a head in the way that we treat each other; and the race as a whole will be doomed for failure. This particular analysis attempts to look at those salient issues and variables which contribute to focus on these negative attitudes and attempts to identify through cases studies where these attitudes came from; and tries to examine what effective strategies can be utilized to correct them; and in essence offer some prescriptive solutions for positive development. Over time, we have collected through case studies some observations which maybe critical in our understanding why these attitudes exist and what can be done to change them.

It is hard for some people to understand that the anger which some young brothers and sisters have had within themselves for a long time; to understand the problems which blacks are confronted with because of their lack of understanding of the system. The most problematic situation that blacks face is that someone; namely systematic simulation experts have placed in their minds negative thoughts, feelings and desires that they are their own worst enemies and that they should dislike and try to destroy each other. This is a sad commentary considering the notion that both black males and females are quick to pull the trigger on each other for blaming each other with being the root causes of their problems. Neither one wants to be held accountable and responsible for their actions and the way that they ought to react to problematic situations. Sisters sometimes put their heads into the sand like the ostrich and refused to deal with their problems and or the negative surroundings around them. Brothers on the other hand are angry individuals who are selfish and they exhibit a behavior in which they only think about themselves. This abnormal behavior on the part of the negative brother creates a serious problem of communication between he and his female counterpart which forces her to adapt some of his negative behavior; in essence what we have occurring within the black race is what I am transcribing now as a failure to communicate. This failure of communication has created a negative void in the way that positive black males and females ought to correspond with each in a harmonious relationship pattern with females which contributes to the positive stability and awareness of the personal growth and stability of the male-female relationship. Unfortunately, the way that these inherent relations among the black female and her man as they exist, today, it appears that nothing positive is every going to happened. How did this negative annihilation of the black race as we once knew it come about? Who is responsible for the destruction of the once proud black race which is rich in cultural heritage and riches of social awareness and several worthy contributions to society? When did it start and how was it resurrected? Let us now start the journey of how this become a reality and analyze what can be done to correct it before the black race is doomed forever and eventually is on its way for total destruction and becoming a footnote in the history of western civilization.

When Did It Start?

The annihilation started in 1968. This was the time that blacks through the civil rights movement under the leadership of Martin Luther King Jr. started to seek the acquisition

of their civil rights and liberties as full fledged American citizens. It was the best of times and it was also the worst of times. In the quest for the acquisition of equality and rights black males faced so many obstacles. First, of all, it started with the advent of the Women Lib Movement of 1972, the system solved the problem of racial equality by getting a black female and a woman into the jobs and economic development structure of the system; in the meantime the black man was pushed back from total acquisition of his rights. What did some sisters do?

1. They looked down on a brother because he did not make as much money as she did.
2. She became a part of the problem instead of the solution because instead of her working with her brother to make him better she started to form coalitions with her white female counterparts some of which whom were avid lesbians and they created a game plan to destroy all men; it did not matter what race or color he was. This perpetuation of radical feminism led to some sisters misunderstanding of what their real role in society is. It is important to note that once a sister begins to advance the concept that no man is necessary and sufficient to her survival that we are entering a “dark hole” in the relationships between black males and females in society.
3. The implementation of the “I am smarter than a man attitude and all brothers are dumb theory. This notion on the part of sisters have destroyed many a black man’s character and his self esteem level more than any of the other negative things that society has perpetuated. Once a man’s ego and self esteem is destroyed by his own woman; he feels that he is of no value to himself and his family. In reality, brothers started to feel that sisters had betrayed them and the civil rights movement all together.
4. The failure of brothers and sisters to communicate led brothers to seek comfort and ego building and total self awareness and fulfillment with the company of others races especially white females; because she was in a power and money struggle of power positioning within our society with her white male counterpart. For the most part these coalitions were good ones because they had a tendency to provide

society with a new cultural awareness that all people can contribute to the worthiness of society. But somewhere along the way some of the sisters and brothers got too greedy and in a very systematic and well devised and calculated scheme only begin to look after themselves and they forget from where they came from.

5. The implementation of the "Crab and Crawfish Theory" this is the theory that perpetuates that as soon as one crab and or crawfish tries to get out of the bucket that you have one or several other crabs who try to hold them back in to the bucket. This theory has been used to define and explain the reason why blacks cannot work with each other and that they cannot in essence relate to each other and get along together.
6. Most blacks are reluctant to want to assist and or help and work with each other. It seems that they have an inherent dislike for the way that some blacks are trying to be successful in dealing with life.
7. The perpetuation of the "ROSCOE Theory". What is the ROSCOE Theory? The ROSCOE Theory states that ROSCOE is a black person who has little and or no self esteem in what they can do in life. These ROSCOE proponents are black people who believe that they are equal to other black persons with the implementation of that notion; that they are equal in all aspects of life to others but yet they are unwilling to make the initial sacrifices which are necessary to become successful. The main problem with ROSCOE is that they seem to be unhappy in the way that they deal with life. I know of a ROSCOE person once who destroyed a billion dollar business operation because they possessed pure jealousy and hate; they believed that what is yours is mine. In our race, we have to be careful and on guard with ROSCOE people they have no heart and no conscience when it comes to destroying positive functions within our society and the black sub community. Our community is at a serious standstill because people who can make an impact in the way that black society is deteriorating; at an unlimited level of systematic sub community self destruction level are refusing to take charge and start making worthy contributions to our black society as a whole. One only has to look at their next door neighbor and within their own family structures to identify things that are not normal with our race. We, namely black people are afraid of our own people

and we do not even trust each other. I am amazed how unhappy some of our black people are and how they want to make a quick dollar and try to mimic and steal ideas from each other. This is a sad commentary considering how we once were a proud and dedicated people such is not the case today.

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
